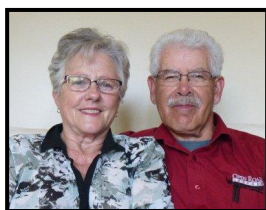
continue his trip, but he said he would call in a couple of days. Tom called 3 days later. He was excited about our conversation and looking forward to further discussion later that week.
