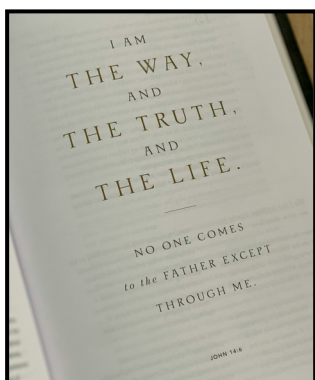
Dear Friends:
